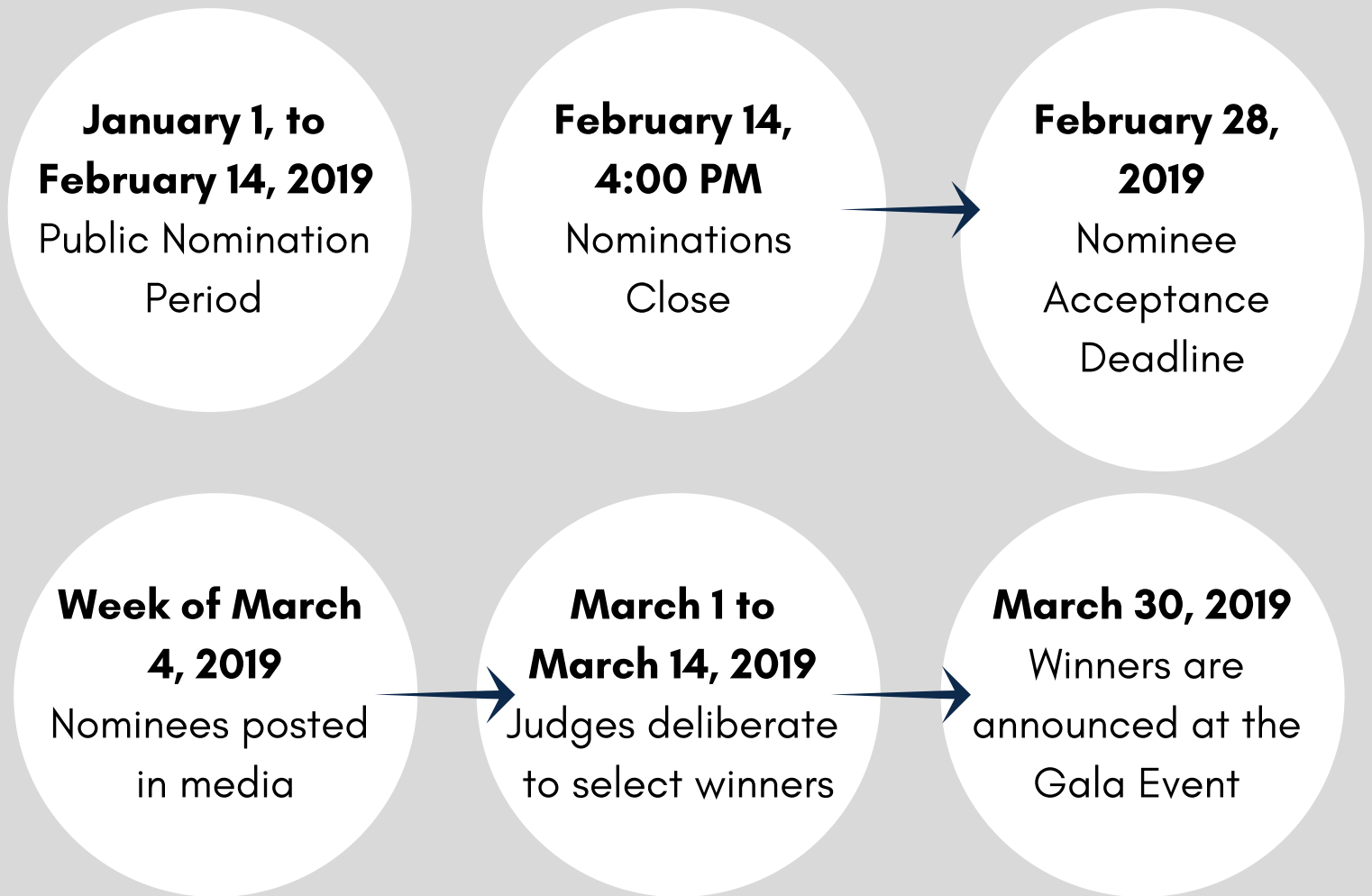

The Judging Process

There are 11 awards that are nominated and judged by the public every year.
The process is described below.

Please note: There is a preliminary screening of nominations for relevance and completeness by Chamber staff! **If the nomination does not answer the questions specific to 2018 it will not be included in the competition.**

Judges are selected by the Manager, President and 1st Vice President of the Chamber.

Judges are chosen for their role in, their collective representation of, and knowledge of the community.

Judges will remain anonymous as an expression of gratitude for their work.

To do their work, judges will receive the nomination forms and nominee acceptance forms.

The judges will score the content of these forms for each nominee against a scoring rubric for each award.

The scores from each judge will be tallied up, and the award will be given to the highest total score.
